

The new building will be safe, in every respect:
in the static and dynamic response of the structures, facing possible fires, radiations and virus transmission.
Much safer than required by current standard rules.



SOCIAL ASPECTS OF A DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Here is a little of '**social**' in provide for.
The building will be much more beautiful than the existing one, with a rebalancing of the unfinished forms, elegant backlit metal coating that will speak - indirectly - of what happens inside.
The social aspect of beauty is undoubted, but beauty can be articulated and perceived in different ways.



SOCIAL ASPECTS OF A DEVELOPMENT PLAN

The new external arrangements, with the eaves road already completed down towards the ring road, will provide an important contribution to the functionality of a road system of the '70s, unacceptable today. CNAO can do nothing alone, but with the contribution of the Municipality and San Matteo, perhaps the area and the air will become more practicable and breathable.



SOCIAL ASPECTS OF A DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Visitors and patients will feel better inside the building, for example in the 250-square-metre waiting room in the underground floor, which will give access to the outpatient sections and the preparation and treatment rooms and will be organised around a glass well that will host a garden.

Light and life brought into the depths of a structure devoted to the treatment of some of man's illnesses.

Together with patients and visitors, the operators will enjoy the use of the new cafeteria-bar on the ground floor, overlooking the renovated Via Campeggi, where the traffic will be one-way and a green barrier will filter noises and light. The exposed roofs of the building will be green.

SOCIAL ASPECTS OF A DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Heating and cooling will be realised by using geothermal sources (groundwater, with intake and return wells), without the use of fossil fuels and production of polluting fumes.

Rainwater will be filtered and taken to the Navigliaccio, with no burden on the city's purification system (the road already built discharges white water into a dispersing trench, essentially feeding the surface water layer).
